Apply for **Transfer** Admission

We recommend that you apply for NJIT transfer ASAP. Due to the ongoing pandemic, you should expect delays in visa appointments and limited flights.

Application should be submitted by April 1

- There is a possibility of delay in your graduation date, if you have CC or below grade at ITU or unsatisfactory grade at NJIT.
